2010 Law Estate Wines Audacious, *Rating 90pts*, Appropriately rugged around the edges, with chewy, gripping tannins. Offers a rich core of dark berry, mocha, espresso and cedar flavors, holding focus through the long finish. Grenache, Cabernet Sauvignon, Syrah and Petite Sirah. Best from 2014 through 2024. 369 cases made.

2010 Law Estate Wines Beguiling, *Rating 91 Pts*, Pure, firm and rich, offering a wide range of dark berry, mocha, cedar, crushed rock and loamy earth flavors, with a gripping edge to the tannins, finishing with a full-bodied aftertaste. Grenache and Syrah. Drink now through 2021. 390 cases made.

2010 Law Estate Wines Intrepid, *Rating 89pts*, Offers pure, rich, ripe notes of dark berry and berry pie, with touches of anise and black licorice. The tannins are muscular but not out of line. Rumbles along on the finish. Syrah. Drink now through 2022. 359 cases made.

2010 Law Estate Wines Sagacious, *Rating 92pts*, Intense and complex, offering a potent mix of wild berry, blackberry and raspberry notes, with touches of pepper and spice, ending with a long, persistent finish that echoes the core berry flavors. Grenache, Syrah and Mourvèdre. Drink now through 2022. 351 cases made.
